

The Republican campaign, says the New York World, is a campaign of fraud and false pretenses.

When he was Secretary of State he made no protest against the imprisonment of Itish-Americans as "suspects" in Eng land, and the great Buffalo meeting presided over by Gov. Quarantine Notice. QUARANTINE FOR THE PORT OF Will Republican agencies and circulated by mington, will be enforced from May 1st to Novomber 1st, as follows :

10 South Front St.

Pilots will bring all vessels from Ports south know it to be a lie, but in their despair of Cape Fear to the Quarantine auchorage: also, all vessels which have had any kind of of finding any truthful charge against sickness on board during the passage or on arrival, and will cause a signal to be set in the main rigging on the port side, as soon as possible after crossing the Bar.

No vessel must leave the Quarantine anchorage, or allow any person, steamer or tug boat, lighter, or boat of any kind to go along si e, unless by written authority from the Quarantine Physician; and every vessel must be an chored as far to the eastward of the channel as is consistent with safety.

Regulations governing vessels while in Quarantine may be had on application at the office of the Quarantine Physician at Smithville

Applications for permits to visit vessels in Quarantine must be made to Dr. Thomas F. Wood or Dr. 6co. G. Thomas, and permits so obtained will be end reed by the Quarantine Physician, if, in his opinion, it is proper and safe to allow communication with such vessels.

A penalty of \$2 0 for each and every offence, will be enforced against any person violating any of the Quarantine Regulations of the Port.




