THE INaugURATION OF THE GOVERNOR.

There has been some discussion recently about the logical and seemingly inconsistent provision of the Constitution as to the beginning of the term of office and the inauguration of the Governor and other State officers.

In 1869, when the Constitution was written, it was logical and harmonious on this question. It provided in Art. II, Section 2, that the Legislature should meet on the third Monday of November.
