The Last Rites.

The obsequies of the late Mr. J. H. Muse took place at his late residence, 306 McRae street, at 9 o'clock yesterday morning and were conducted by Rev. Dr. Pritchard of the First Baptist Church. A large concourse of people assembled to manifest their respect for the memory of the deceased, among whom were representatives of almost every walk in life. A touching tribute to the respect in which he was held was the assemblage of nearly all the printers, bookbinders, pressmen and those connected with the press of the city, who, at the conclusion of the impressive ceremonies at the house, took positions in front of the carriages containing the pall bearers, and thus escorted the remains of their friend, co-laborer and fellow citizen to their last resting place in the quiet of Bellevue. Arriving near the grave they opened ranks and facing inward stood uncovered until the funeral cortege had passed, when they assembled with the others around the spot where the body of their friend was to be consigned to the earth from whence it came. The ceremonies at the grave were impressive and touching, and especially so in the floral tributes which were offered. A sheaf of wheat with a floral sash at its base, with a cross and wreath, were beautiful and tender symbols that seemed to speak to every heart present. The other floral offerings were appropriate and in exquisite taste. Thus, on the morning of a beautiful Autumnal Sabbath the remains of our loved friend and co-laborer were laid to rest. The relentless reaper Death came to him as a sheaf fully ripe for the sickle and ready to be garnered. May the turf rest lightly above him, and while the flowers which mark his last resting place will wither and die, may the fragrant blossoms of his truth, love, devotion and pure life shed their sweet fragrance over his bereaved household.

An Outrage.
Mr. H. M. Bishop, who lives on Masonboro Sound, went to Stump Sound, in Onslow county, on the first of October last, taking with him seven men and six boats, intending to engage in the oyster business for the season. On the night of Oct. 3d, just three days after he had commenced operations, some thief or thieves stole all the boats from the landing where they were kept and took them about a mile distant on to the marsh and cut them all to pieces; in fact, making kindling wood of them. Mr. Bishop was working upon the ground of his nephew, Mr. John Bishop, with whom the former had made a regular contract, and had rented some of the buildings of the latter, and by this outrage both men are equally damaged. Strong suspicions point to certain parties as the perpetrators of the crime, but as yet there is not sufficient proof to be able to secure their conviction. It is to be hoped that they may be found out and awarded the punishment the crime richly merits.
