The figures from the Blue Book relating to election expenses last year in England are very suggestive. Every other well known breeder is represented by from half a dozen to 15 estries The same preeders are represented in the realiza tion stakes, which will probably be worth \$40,000 when run for. Yearlings which have been nominated for this stake must be entered by July 15 next, to be eligible to run for the rich prize at the spring meeting in 1886. There are 217 foals entered for the stakes.


