Long Tunnels.

The total length of the Severn tunnel is four miles 624 yards. The St Gothard trunel is 9 1 2 miles. Mont Cenis tunnel 7 1-8 miles. Ariberg tunnel (Lustria), 6 1 2 miles. There is a tunnel in Massachusetts 4 3-4 miles; the Standege tunnel, on the London and Northwestern, is three miles long and the Box tunnel rather less. But the special feature of the Severn tunnel lies in the fact that 2 1-4 miles of it have been constructed from forty-five to 100 feet below the bed of a rapid flowing ide estnary, offering engineering difficulties which make it the most remarkable tunnel in the world .- Philadelphia
