The total amount on deposit in the savings banks of the United States, according to the latest reports—1886-7—is \$1,235,247,371. The banks of New York and Massachusetts held \$778,684,680, while all the rest of the Union South and West of the Alleghenies and below the Ohio held but \$105,488,702.

Prof. John M. Langston, of Virginia, has joined ex-Senator Bruce and Fred Douglass in opposing the scheme to bring about a negro exodus to South America. He thinks the proposed exodus is a fraud from first to last, and that there is no need for it.

Samples of the rolled steel lately turned out by the Henderson Steel Company, of Birmingham, Ala., have been placed on exhibition in Mobile. The officers of the company are charmed with the success of the new process, and say that the tests have proved that steel can be made from the lowest grade of Alabama iron.

The St. Tammany Lumber Company of Michigan has purchased many thousands of acres of wooded lands North of Lake Pontchartrain, La., and proposes to go into business on an extensive scale there. These Michiganers have, for years past, been large purchasers of Louisiana woodlands, and have secured a considerable share of the 2,500,000 acres recently bought by Westerners.

Reports recently received at the Navy Department concerning the work on the new vessels are satisfactory to the department officers, and most of the expectations of Secretary Whitney will be met by the builders. The Charleston, building at San Francisco, is the most advanced of all those in construction. The Union Iron Works are doing very little on the San Francisco, and cannot push her construction ahead until the rush for material on other works they have in hand has somewhat abated.
