The woman suffrage question has come to a vote again in the Massachusetts Legislature, as in every Legislature with but two exceptions since 1867. The measure was presented only in the restricted form of a proposition to grant women the right to vote in municipal elections, but it secured only 35 affirmative votes to 107 in the negative.
