CHRISTMAS AT ST. PAUL'S.

The Rebate on Tobacco and Snuff.

Collector White has received directions in regard to the rebate allowed on plug and smoking tobacco and snuff under the recent amendment to the law. Rebates are allowed to dealers, wholesale and retail, as well as manufacturers, but no rebate is allowed where the amount claimed is less than \$5.

An inventory of all unbroken packages must be taken on the 1st day of January by the claimant in the presence of two credible witnesses, and an affidavit must be made of the same on a blank which the department will furnish. These blanks are being sent out now as fast as the clerks can get them off. After the inventory is made and sworn to by the claimant and witnesses, it must be forwarded to the deputy collector of that division. The affidavits can be made before a justice of the peace, but the clerk of the court must certify that he is an acting justice, &c. No clerk or employee of the claimant can be a witness. The inventory must be taken and finished on the 1st day of January.
