From Havana.

HAVANA, March 23.

The Governor of Trinidad Villa Clara and Col. Mendez, who commands the forces near Remedios, are accused of disloyalty.

Several hundred volunteers have gone over to the enemy.

General Letona's advance guard had been defeated by the rebels near Cienfuegos.

Several expeditions from the United States, well equipped, are known to have recently landed.

Cuban accounts of expeditions to raise the siege of Puerto Principe are unfavorable to the Spaniards.

From New York.

NEW YORK, March 23.

A packed Cuban meeting was held here today, Mayor Hall presiding. Charles A. Dana read resolutions expressing sympathy with the Cuban patriots and urging the government to recognize them as belligerents. Adopted en-

thusiastically.

## OUR NIGHT REPORTS.

From Georgia.

SAVANNAH, March 23.

Judge Schley rendered a decision this morning in quo warranto in the case of Clements vs. White, that negroes were ineligible to office in the State of Georgia.

A decision by the Board of Arbitration today in favor of Mitchell & Co. vs. the city of Brunswick, involving over a million of dollars was decided in favor of the defendants.

## FROM WASHINGTON.

WASHINGTON, March 26.

CONGRESSIONAL.—The House committee on foreign affairs reported a resolution declaring sympathy with the people of Cuba in their efforts to secure independence and establish a republican government; also repeats a former resolution authorizing the President to recognize Cuba, which was recommitted and ordered to be printed.

The tenure-of-office bill was resumed, and after a long and demoralizing debate a motion to commit to the Senate was carried, defeated by a vote of 59 to 96. The bill goes back to the Senate as a simple repeat. The House then adjourned until Monday.

In the Senate an effort to take up the Memphis and El Paso bill failed.

All bills before the Convention of July 7, 1783, with Mexico, was passed.

The currency bill was discussed without action. After which the Senate adjourned until Monday.
