Warrants were issued, yesterday, for Sandy

by the Magistrate that if they voted, they

hearing before Justice McQuigg yesterday.

The evidence was to the effect that he rented
a room in the Fourth Ward before the 1st of
December; that he was married on the night
after Christmas to a woman in the Third
Ward and went to reside with her, still retain-
ing his room in the Fourth Ward, intending to
remove there as soon as his wife's time was
out where she resided, which it was testified
would expire last night. On this evidence the
defendant was discharged.
