Commissioner's Court.
Yesterday afternoon Hardy Royal, Ralford Royal, David Braysdon, Charles Crumpler and Louis Honeycutt, arrested on a warrant issued by Commissioner McQuigg, on the sidewalk of Gabriel Rial, charged with implication in the conspiracy to murder Mennis Herring on the 23rd of September last, were arraigned before the Commissioner's Court.
