## NORTH CAROLINA MEDICAL CONFERENCE.

Third Day—Tuesday.

[Statesville Intelligencer.] The Society was called to order at 9 o'clock, President Whitehead in the chair.

The Committee on Credentials submitted a partial report, recommending Drs. Walter J. Melendson of Anson; J. W. Vick of Selma; John A. Allison of Irredell; Albert G. Carr of Carey; W. G. Johnson of Farmington; Jacob M. Hadley, LaGrange; John B. Gaither of Salisbury; F. L. Murphy of New Bern; and J. E. Greene, of Warren, to membership.

The Committee on Obituaries were then appointed, and consists of Drs. Thos. F. Wood, G. G. Thomas and W. J. Love, of Wilmington, N. C.

Dr. Bohnsen, chairman of the Committee on Anesthesia, (entomology and ether) read an able essay on this subject, which was referred to the Committee on Publication.

In the order of business the hour arrived for the installation of officers for the ensuing year, and Drs. Semmell and Hines were appointed to conduct the newly elected President to the chair, and Dr. W. A. B. Norcom, of Edenton, took his seat.

The retiring President, Dr. Whitehead, returned his thanks to the Society for the distinguished honor which had been conferred upon him, by his having been called to preside over the deliberations of the noble body of men who compose the State Medical Society of North Carolina, and in a beautiful, instructive and eloquent address upon the advancement of the science of medicine, the duties of the profession, and the relations of art to the progressive science of medicine. He took his seat amid a perfect roar of applause; whereupon Dr. Satchwell offered the following resolution which was unanimously adopted:

*Resolved*, That the thanks of the Society are due, and are hereby tendered to our retiring President, Dr. M. Whitehead, for his impartial and efficient administering of the duties of his office, and also for the apt and eloquent valedictory address just delivered, and that he be requested to furnish a copy to the Secretary for publication in our transactions.

Upon motion of Dr. R. L. Payne, the thanks of the Society were tendered to the citizens of Statesville for the kind hospitality extended to the members of the Society during the present meeting.

Dr. Summerell made some practical remarks upon the treatment of eclampsia.
