CONFEDERATE REUNION.

The Third Georgia at Portsmouth. [From the Portsmouth Department of the Norfolk Evening Times of Wednesday.] Never has there been given in our city before such a warm and hearty reception as was given to the veterans of the Third Georgia Regiment upon their arrival here yesterday evening. As the boats pulled up the ladies waved their handkerchiefs, the crowd congregated cheered, the band played a lively air, but above all was heard the roar of artillery. At the depot they were met by a large concourse of citizens, ex-Confederates, the Chambers Fire Company, and the members of the Committee of Arrangements for the reception. They then formed in line and were escorted to Oxford Hall, where welcoming speeches were made by Hon. A. S. W. W. Mayor of Portsmouth, Capt. John H. Gayle, Capt. Claude W. Mardian, and Col. David J. Godwin. Replies to the above were made by Col. Claiborne Snead, D. A. Carter, Esq., and Capt. Thomas Carroll. After the speeches were finished the veterans were conducted to Maupin's Hall, where an elegant ovation was in waiting for them, and where they enjoyed themselves up to a late hour last night. The organization known as the Veterans of the late Third Georgia Regiment assembled at Oxford Hall this morning at 10 o'clock. Col. Claiborne Snead, President, called the meeting to order, and Capt. A. A. Winn, Secretary, read the proceedings of the last meeting, which were approved. Major George W. Grice then read letters from Chief Engineer D. S. Cherry, of the Portsmouth Fire Department, and Hon. John B. Whitehead, Mayor of Norfolk. Three cheers were then given for Major Grice, and in addition, at the courtesy of the Chief Engineer were accepted. On motion, the Chairman appointed Capt. S. A. Coker, Capt. S. H. Starr, Capt. J. K. Wright, Sergeant T. Chambers, Sergeant J. M. Lindsay, a committee on business, to report to-morrow morning at 8 o'clock. A letter from Capt. C. A. Andrews, the historian, regretting his absence on account of family affliction, was read by the Secretary. Commodore Dexter presented the members of the history of the regiment, requesting the members to send suggestions to the historian at Mason's Hall, 221 Broadway, New York.

Suitable resolutions were ordered to be drawn up in regard to the death of two members. Capt. Coker moved that a committee of one from each company be appointed to read and revise the history, and to report at the next annual reunion. Adopted. After transacting some other business the meeting adjourned for ten minutes.

At half-past 11 o'clock Col. Snead again called the meeting to order and introduced Col. R. B. Nesbit, who delivered an able and eloquent address, which was received with enthusiastic applause.

On the conclusion of Col. Nesbit's speech Capt. S. A. Coker, on behalf of the regiment, presented to the citizens of Portsmouth a beautiful blue silk flag which has inscribed on one side the motto of Georgia, and on the other "Second re-union of 3d Georgia Regiment, Portsmouth, Va."
