- Senator Bayard, who has been interviewed in Washington, says that, in his opinion, Secretary Sherman will require an act of Congress, authorizing the payment of customs with greenbacks.

- Miss Cook, Mrs. Hayes' niece, who was married the other day, is the fifth of the young ladies who have visited Mrs. llayes at the White House who has married within eighteen months. The others are the two Misses Sullivant, Miss Platt and Miss Macfarland.

- The late Commodore Vanderbilt didn't have much of an ear for music. He once emphatically remarked: "All modern music seems d-d nonsense to me; I prefer the old tunes." This testimony was adduced to show that the old man's head wasn't exactly level.

SOUTHERN ITEMS.

- The absconding merchant, Redmoud, of Nashville, Tenn , has been captured at Chattanooga, in that State. He had \$8,000 or \$10,000 in his value.

- The \$1,000 given to Jerry Haralson, of Alabama, by the Radical Congressional Committee, to be used in his campaign against Gen. Shelley, was invested in a farm.
