OUTLINES.

Northern parties have contracted with the authorities of Florida to drain Lake Okechobee, with a view to the reclamation of a large body of land. James Gadsden killed his mother in a drunken carousal at Chattanooga, Tenn. A petition from 30,000 citizens was presented to the Senate praying Congress to observe the treaties and do justice to the Indian tribes. A bill was introduced to establish a uniform system of bankruptcy. Mr. Beck took the advocacy of free ships, and was supported by Mr. Blaine. In the House a contested election case from Ohio was introduced. Ten ballots for U. S. Senator have been taken by the Pennsylvania legislature without an election. In the Senate the bodies of four women and a child have been found horribly mutilated and buried. The Catholic clergy have declared that an immediate reformation of the law will call back peace and security, but which they fear the House will not do or fail to do. Mr. Tilden has been urged to leave the House to the voters and not participate in a diatribe. A bill to prohibit the importation of cattle from countries where cattle disease is known to exist was introduced in Parliament. The House introduced the charges of fraud in the case of Canadian officials in the matter of the Halifax award. The Catholic Archbishop of Vienna is dead. Mr. Secretary Thompson has concluded his resignation in favor of the Panama Canal. The House Committee on Foreign Affairs has reported on the case of the late John A. Dix. Miss Calhoun was treated to a reception at the Exchange Hotel, Richmond, after her first performance. She was also serenaded afterwards. The State says:

The general disposition here among our people is to treat this lady not only as a representative of art, but as a worthy daughter of South Carolina. We like frank, candid criticism, even though it be a pretty, gifted young Southern woman who is the subject. Hence, we have read with interest the Richmond Dispatch's first criticism of Miss Calhoun's Juliet. We give some of the salient points: "Miss Calhoun is pretty, not beautiful. Her action is careful, well conceived, and indeed, to a remarkable degree free from glaring faults for one so new to the stage. Her voice is strong, and even musical; her actions sometimes exhibiting a want of consistency, but never awkwardness; yet, withal, we cannot say with truthful conviction from this her first appearance with us that she has genius. Unquestionably she possesses great dramatic talent, and we only wish we could with certainty predict the extent of her talent. Her Juliet is a fine specimen of the actress. She was called before the curtain at the end of the second and fifth acts, though after the first greeting the audience did not seem enthusiastic. Senator Lamar did not eulogize Grant. The New Yorkers are talking of finishing up the East River Bridge, that has cost so many millions and been in course of erection more than a decade, and of completing also the Hudson River Tunnel by the World's Fair in 1883. It would be safe to bet that neither would be done, and particularly the latter. The Tunnel will be built, as there is plenty of capital. It is being pushed, and the engineers are confident that it will be successful. The celebrated Thames Tunnel will be a small affair compared with this one when done. This is a low price, as he says he has frequently realized 40 cents per lb. for his oil. Wilson is known over the county as "the oil nigger." Raleigh News-Observer: Sixty shares of Raleigh National Bank stock were sold yesterday at auction by R. H. Battle, Esq., executor of the late Hon. W. H. Battle and others. The price obtained was \$90 per share. The Board of Agriculture, at its recent meeting, passed a resolution directing the State geologist to deliver a lecture on the mineral wealth of the State.
