DEMOCRATIC ORGANIZATION.

Plan of Organization of the Democratic Party of North Carolina. ROOMS DEM. CENTRAL EX. COM., RALEIGH, May 20, 1882. This committee hereby publish the plan of organization of the Democratic party compiled from the rules and amendments heretofore adopted by the State Democratic Executive Committee.

TOWNSHIP ORGANIZATION. 1. The unit of county organization shall be the township. In each township there shall be an executive committee to consist of five active Democrats, who shall be elected by the Democratic voters of the several townships in meetings called by the county executive committee. And said committee so elected shall elect one of its members as chairman, who shall preside at all said committee meetings.

GENERAL RULES. 1. Such delegate (or alternates of absent delegates) as may be present at any Democratic convention, shall be allowed to cast the whole vote to which their township or county may be entitled. 2. In all conventions provided by this system, after a vote is cast, there shall be no change in such vote until the final result of the ballot shall be announced by the chairman of said convention.

3. That the chairmen of the different county conventions shall certify the list of delegates and alternates of absent delegates, and a certified list of said delegates and alternates to the Secretary of the State Central Committee. STATE CONVENTIONS.

The State convention shall be composed of delegates appointed by the several county conventions. Each county shall be entitled to elect one delegate and one alternate for every one hundred and fifty Democratic votes, and one delegate for fractions over seventy-five Democratic votes cast therein at the last preceding gubernatorial election; and none but delegates or alternates so elected shall be entitled to seats in said convention; provided that every county shall have at least one vote in said convention.

GENERAL RULES. 1. Such delegate (or alternates of absent delegates) as may be present at any Democratic convention, shall be allowed to cast the whole vote to which their township or county may be entitled. 2. In all conventions provided by this system, after a vote is cast, there shall be no change in such vote until the final result of the ballot shall be announced by the chairman of said convention.

3. That the chairmen of the different county conventions shall certify the list of delegates and alternates of absent delegates, and a certified list of said delegates and alternates to the Secretary of the State Central Committee.
