LETTERS TO THE IROQUOIS CLUB OF CHICAGO. MR. TILDEN'S LETTER. "On the formation of the Federal Constitution, when Gouverneur Morris, who had been a conspicuous member of the convention, being asked what he thought of the constitution, replied: 'That depends upon how it is construed.'"

THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY ORIGINATED in the resistance by the more advanced patriots of the revolution to efforts which were made to change the character of our government by a false construction of the constitution and imposing on the new system a monarchical bias.

MR. JEFFERSON'S ELECTION in 1800 rescued our free institutions from the perils which surrounded them, and secured sixty years of administration mainly in harmony with their design and true character. When an attempt was made to break up the Union and dismember the territorial integrity of the country people were compelled to make a manly choice between these calamities and the dangerous influence of a civil war upon the character of the government.

AS LONG AS 1876 I expressed the opinion that the opposition must embrace at the beginning of the canvass two-thirds of the voters to maintain a majority at the election. In this history repeats itself. In most countries the government maintains itself by force or fraud.

NO REFORM OF administration is possible so long as the government is directed by a party which is under the dominion of false doctrines and animated by enormous pecuniary interests in the perpetration of existing abuses. The first effectual step in the reform of our government must be a fundamental change in the policy of its administration.

IT IS WITH GREAT REGRET that I find myself unable to accept your invitation to attend and address the Iroquois Club on the 18th. I had greatly desired to do so, but failed to do so, and my duties here as to permit of my absence. The Democratic party is passing through an important crisis just now. It is preparing to determine whether it is a party of principle or of expediency; whether it will try to do right or simply try to get in. It is only distinguished

from its adversaries by the fact that it is "out" let us say so like honest men. DEMOCRATIC ORGANIZATION. Plan of Organization of the Democratic Party of North Carolina. ROOMS DEM. CENTRAL EX. COM., Raleigh, May 20, 1882. This committee hereby publish the plan of organization of the Democratic party compiled from the rules and amendments heretofore adopted by the State Democratic Executive Committee.

TOWNSHIP ORGANIZATION. 1. The unit of county organization shall be the township. In each township there shall be an executive committee to consist of five active Democrats, who shall be elected by the Democratic voters of the several townships in meetings called by the county executive committee. And said committee so elected shall elect one of its members as chairman, who shall preside at all said committee meetings.

GENERAL RULES. 1. Such delegate (or alternates of absent delegates) as may be present at any Democratic convention, shall be allowed to cast the whole vote to which their township or county may be entitled.
