THE COTTON CROP.

December Report of the Department of Agriculture.

WASHINGTON, December 30.—The Department report of the Department of Agriculture upon the cotton product in 1884, smaller than the returns of the condition in October. The October average was 74 against 68 in 1883, and 68 in the greatest harvest of 1882, and 68 in the greatest harvest of 1881.

MISSOURI. Suicide of a Catholic Priest at St. Louis—Business Failure.

St. Louis, December 30.—The inquest today on the body of Father Ruppilin, who took strichnine in a saloon on Sunday, terminated in a verdict of suicide. The deceased left letters and certificates concerning this full name was Rev. Ferdinand Baron Von Ruppilin, Catholic Priest. One of the letters read: "I committed suicide on account of poverty and incurable sickness. I had no money, no home, no means, and may God help me."

Another letter, in the hand writing of the deceased, says that he was born at Frauenthal, Canton Thurgau, Switzerland, March 17, 1841. That he was a son of Baron Joseph Von Ruppilin, and that he was ordained a Catholic priest at Buffalo, N. Y., December 17, 1870, by Bishop Stephen Vincent Ryan. The body will be buried in the St. Louis cemetery.
