The tariff question was discussed both in the Senate and House yesterday, Mr. Voorhees making a lengthy speech in the Senate, and Messrs. Bynum, of Indiana, Browne of Indiana, Dockery, of Missouri, Shaw, of Maryland, and Glass, of Missouri, making speeches in the House.
An agreement has been reached in the Ways and Means Committee upon the time to be allowed for general debate in the House upon the tariff.
Republican State Conventions were held in Massachusetts and Pennsylvania yesterday for the selection of delegates to the Chicago National Convention; the delegates selected from Massachusetts are understood to strongly favor Blaine's nomination.
Yesterday's offerings of government bonds aggregated \$3,023,000.
A bulletin issued yesterday morning says Emperor Frederick passed a good night, and that his condition is satisfactory.
Negro troubles prevail at Bessemer, Ala., and fears were prevalent Monday night that the town would be burned; a late telegram, however, reports all quiet, but a feverish apprehension still prevails that the trouble is not ended.
The high school building at Concord, N. H., was burned yesterday; all of the children escaped in safety.
The aggregate of bonds accepted to date at the treasury, \$3,525,000.
The Southern Immigration Convention met at Hot Springs, N. C., yesterday; large delegations are present from a number of Southern States, including many distinguished persons.
Very cold weather is reported in Virginia, with heavy frosts, and it is thought the fruit crop is ruined.
A murder and suicide are reported from Nelsonville, Ohio, and in Rochester, N. Y., a man killed his wife from jealousy, and then attempted to kill himself.
A war of extermination has been declared in Manchester, N. H., against all liquor dealers, and a number of places have been raided by the league for the suppression of the liquor traffic.

The Democrats intend to scatter the needed economic literature. The people should read and inform themselves as to the great burdens and inequalities of an unjust, unconstitutional War Tariff. The Washington special to the World says:
"The demand for Mr. Mills's speech on opening the tariff debate and for his report on the Ways and Means bill is something unprecedented. Nothing like it has ever been known before. Already orders have been received for 153,000 copies of the speech and 800,000 copies of the report. Representative Scott, of Pennsylvania will distribute 25,000 of the speeches, and Representative Mahoney, of New York, 30,000, while a dozen members have ordered 5,000 and over. The speech costs \$4.68 per thousand to members of Congress."

The Committee would do well to print 200,000 copies of Senator Vance's able articles contributed to the Baltimore Sun. They are thoughtful and forceful.

Died, on Monday, April 23d, in Brooklyn, Long Island, Mrs. Mary I. Kingsbury, widow of the late Gen. Charles P. Kingsbury, U. S. Army. She was a native of Fayetteville, N. C. —The steamer D. Murchison left late yesterday afternoon for Fayetteville with a large freight.

—The meeting of stockholders of the Bellevue Cemetery Company last night failed for lack of a quorum.
—Mr. George A. Ramsay left for New York last night in furtherance of his scheme for the development of Pender, Duplin and Onslow counties.

—The cold weather of the last two or three mornings has no doubt caused slight injury to truck farms, although there has been no frost reported in this section.

—The Star is indebted to Mr. N. J. Reid, photographer of Dobson, Surry county, for a large photograph of the grand old Pilot Mountain, showing the only ascent accessible, which is by means of ladders.

—Commander B. P. Lambertor, who has been in charge of the light-houses in this (the Sixth) district has been detached, to take effect June 30, and Lieut. Commander R. B. Hitchcock has been ordered as assistant inpector of the Sixth light house district, May 1, and as inspector of that district June 30.

—The house of Stephen Bowen, colored, on MacRae street near Mulberry, caught on fire yesterday afternoon about 8 o'clock. The fire was on the roof near the chimney, and was put out in a few minutes. The damage was trifling. An alarm was turned in which brought out the fire department, but the services of the firemen were not needed.

—It is about time to make arrangements for the approaching encampment of the State Guard. There is every indication that the city will be filled with visitors on that occasion. Already we hear of numerous applications made for accommodations during encampment week, and some of the proprietors of boarding houses say that they have had applications from more persons than they can accommodate.

A New Railroad.
Mr. George A. Ramsay, one of Pender's most enterprising citizens, has perfected arrangements to build a railroad from Burgaw, on the Wilmington & Weldon road, to Jacksonville, in Onslow county. The road is an assured fact and will be built this summer, we are told. Although only twenty-eight miles in length its completion will tend to the development of a large section of the most fertile and valuable farming lands in the State, which for want of means of transportation and lack of communication with business centres are now lying idle and unproductive.

In connection with this railroad enterprise a Land and Improvement Company has been formed, for the purpose of opening up the country to settlement and affording inducements for a desirable class of immigrants. Truck farming is one of the industries that the road is expected to promote, and which it is believed the country is admirably adapted to, early fruits and vegetables maturing here almost as soon as the crops of the truckers in the neighborhood of Savannah, Ga., with the advantage of being in easy reach of the Northern markets.

The Drummers' License Tax.
A case that excited considerable interest was tried in Justice Millis Court, involving the constitutional-ity of the tax on drummers and peddlers. B. F. Wilson, representing a manufacturing concern in Columbus, Ga., was engaged in taking orders for suits of men's clothing, exhibiting samples of goods from which selections were made, and was arrested on the charge of peddling without license; section 28 of the Laws of 1887 requiring the payment of a license tax of twenty-five dollars in each county. Mr. Marsden Bellamy appeared as counsel for Wilson, while Mr. H. A. Bagg, chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, was present in behalf of the county. After hearing argument, the Justice decided to order the prisoner discharged, on the ground that the U. S. Supreme Court has decided the State law imposing the license tax to be unconstitutional.
