BRYAN IN TENNESSEE.

HIS JOURNEY FROM ST. LOUIS TO MEMPHIS.

Cheered All Along the Route—Enthusiastically Welcomed—Thousands of People Assembled at Memphis and Nashville to Hear the Distinguished Speaker.

MEMPHIS, TENN., October 5.—The visit of Mr. Bryan to Memphis was made the occasion of a general holiday.

Business houses closed their doors and even the banks suspended for the day.

It was 10.30 a. m. when Mr. Bryan, under escort of the Neely Zouaves, and accompanied by the local reception committee, reached Overton tract, a big open field where the speaking took place.

He found there a dense crowd, estimated at 15,000 people. The audience was not composed wholly of Memphians.

Large contingents not only from Arkansas and Mississippi, but from Alabama and Kentucky, with of course large numbers from near by places in Tennessee.

Shrill cheers, that increased in intensity, went up from the assemblage as Mr. Bryan took the platform.

He was greeted with the volume of sound being deafening as he mounted the covered platform, erected in the center of the field.

On the stand with Mr. Bryan were Senator Harris and Bate, of Tennessee, E. W. Carmack, Silver Democratic nominee for Congress from this district, representative Ben O. Hill, of Illinois, and J. C. Overton, Jr., Chairman of the Memphis Reception Committee.

Senator Harris presented Mr. Bryan, who spoke for half an hour to the Tennessee people.

The most interesting part of his address was his comment upon the Congressional fight in the Memphis tract.

He said that the bill introduced by Mr. Carmack, the Silver Democratic nominee, who is opposed by Josiah Patterson, was a good man, but supporting the Chicago ticket.

Leaving that subject Mr. Bryan continued:

"My friends, I am not here to interfere with your State campaign or local politics. I am here to increase the enthusiasm, if I can, until the man who stands in the way of complete emancipation is branded as an enemy.

(Great applause.) How you may find it best to unify our forces, you are to judge; but my friends, I want you to remember that you cannot help our cause by helping those who are fighting us.

(Great applause.) If we are right in the position we are taking, the Democratic party is right in its platform, then the man who does not stand upon that platform, no matter how good a Democrat he may be before, is no Democrat now. (Applause.) And no man can claim to be a friend of mine who says he wants to elect me because I am the regular nominee, and then go down there and tie my hands and make me powerless. (Applause.)

I could not feel the interest that I do in this campaign if all I had to commend me was party regularity. (Applause.) I appeal to you on higher ground than that. I have a stronger claim upon your support than can be given by regularity of a convention. I stand by the right of the American people to have a financial system that will not drive them to the beginning of our century, and I stand by the right of the American people to have a complete discussion, if you will, of the time you will find that the newspapers which are so quick to grasp any item of news and so ready to spread it before the public, are not so quick to explain that the law of 1875 demonetized silver and left us with gold only as a standard money.
