YELLOW FEVER AT SELMA.

SEVEN CASES OF THE DISEASE DECLARED BY DOCTOR GUTERAS.

MONTGOMERY, Ala., October 23.—The official report of the Board of Health at 4 o'clock today is as follows: Cases previously reported, 84; cases to-day, 13 in town and one rural miles to the country. Deaths previously reported, two; to-day, none. Since the report of the Board John W. Deming, an alderman and agent of the Georgia & Alabama Railroad, has died. His case was the only one reported to-day.

MEMPHIS, Tenn., Oct. 23.—There is only one case of yellow fever in Memphis, according to the report of the Board of Health to-night. The patient is a colored man named McFarren, who is reported as convalescing. There is little or no excitement here and business is going on as usual.
