

Make Search For Relatives.
 Nov. 21.—Postmaster at Darcy, Arkansas, has received a message from the postmaster at Darcy, Arkansas, asking him to make a search for relatives of W. E. Basinger, who was reported at that place 10 days ago. Basinger declares that the writer is his brother and that its purpose is to do justice by the deceased. Mr. Basinger is a man of property, and the writer declared that there was danger of losing it unless friends took action. The family here. Mr. Basinger once started an investigation into the disclosure that Mr. Basinger, of Morgan town, was the father of the murdered man who was about 40 years of age. The senior Basinger married a woman from his son about a year ago and he had recovered entirely from a pistol shot wound received about a month ago. He will at once inquire into the murder which is entirely new and of which the writer has nothing until to-day.

 Nov. 21.—Six freight trains which left here for Greensboro, were wrecked near Colfax. Elias Fulp and Newell, two white boys from Greenville, who were hobnobbing, were killed by one of the cars and badly injured. The crew of the wrecked train reported tonight that a white boy had been crushed to death. The boy has not been learned. The injured were brought to the hospital here on a special. The wreck was the worst that has ever occurred on this line. The track is torn some distance.
