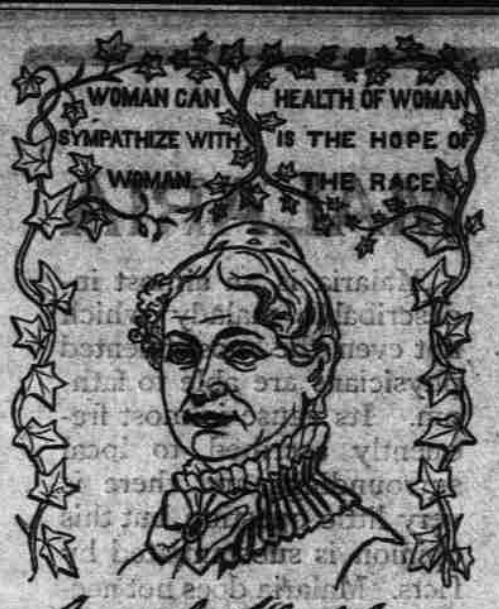
AN INCIDENT OF VANCE

Mrs. Gray, who was present at the scene,
and who has been sentenced to be hanged next
November. The death of his wife is sup-
posed to have caused the act.

against 1,739,988 and 1,144,247 respec-
tively last year.
