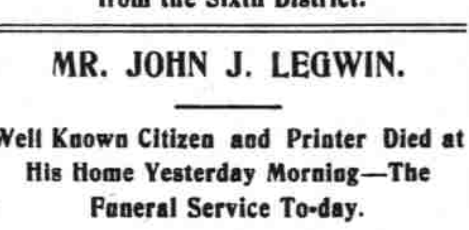

HON. JOHN D. BELLAMY. Who was Tuesday re-elected by an overwhelming majority to Congress from the Sixth District.



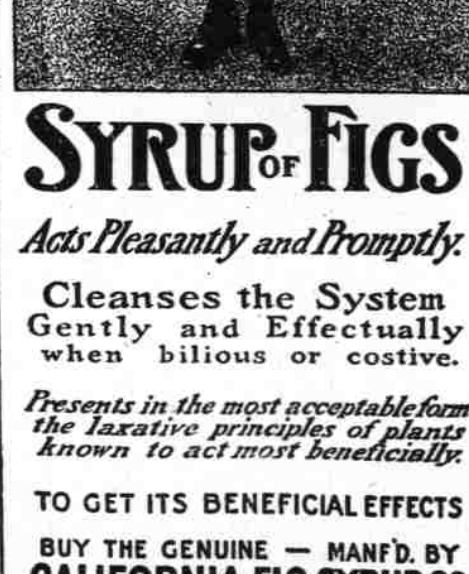
