1. Preserving Meat Without Salt.—We need salt as a preservative to our food, but it is not essential to the preservation of our meats...

2. Pennicium is dried meat, pounded fine and packed in its own grease. Mr. Ballantyne, who was in the service of the Hudson Bay Company...

3. Fresh Meat may be kept sweet for double the usual time by wrapping it in corn meal, removed and renewed as often as it becomes wet or sour.

4. Wheat Flour.—"The finest of the wheat" is not always the best; the whiter the flour the less the nourishment.

5. Mashed Bread.—When a wheaten loaf is allowed to stand and cool for some hours after being taken from the oven...

6. Graham Bread, or bread made from unbleached wheat, is coarse and rather unpalatable, but it is far more nutritious than bread made from more costly flour...
