MAJOR GAMES between the "Pioneers" and "Tar Heels" Base Ball Clubs, Raleigh, N. C., Nov. 2nd, 1890.

Decidedly the most attractive and interesting entertainment we have lately enjoyed was the match game, between the two Base Ball Clubs, of our City, which took place yesterday afternoon on Nash Square. The delight anticipated was abundantly evinced by the large concourse of spectators, and the anticipations were fully realized, if we may judge by unmistakable demonstrations. Nearly one thousand persons, including the "beauty and chivalry," the elite and ton of the community, witnessed with intense and absorbing interest the progress of the game, and gave encouragement by smiles and cheers.

The challenge was given, two weeks since, by the "Pioneer Club," and the game was played upon the ground of the challenged party. Punctually at two, the hour appointed, the nine players from the Pioneers appeared, creating a very favorable impression by their manly and rather soldierly bearing. Their uniform was striking, and more like sporting costume than that of their competitors, the loose red shirt and open collar with white star contrasting well with the black velvet cap and black pantaloons. Either the name or the gray shirt of the "Tar Heels" was many to their side by memories tender, though their all-black caps and black pantaloons, somewhat neutralized the "rebellious" tendencies. The contrast between the nine was made more evident, as they were drawn up to receive the charge of the Empire, R. W. Best, Esq., the superior size and age of the Pioneers telling in their favor.

The game opened with some spirit, the "Tar Heels" having the first innings though they played with trepidation, either the presence of so many bright eyes, or the contest with more experienced players, rendering them somewhat nervous. Two runs, well made, and the "Pioneers" had the innings. Unconscious to the grounds, they labored under a disadvantage, and did not play as well as their reputation justly entitled the lookers-on to expect. Making but two runs, their competitors again had the innings, and made three runs. The side being placed out, the "Pioneers," on their second innings, made only one run.

Public expectation as to the progress of the game was awakened, as it had been hoped the Pioneers would make an easy success. At the close of the third inning, the Tar Heels were one ahead, having scored runs six for the Pioneers. The fourth innings decided the game, the Tar Heels not making a run, and the Pioneers twelve! The result of the game was then regarded a fore-gone conclusion.

The fifth innings showed the most successful batting and running for both clubs, and we may say the most successful field playing. The Tar Heels made in this inning sixteen runs, and the Pioneers thirteen. But even with this the game stood twenty-three runs, Tar Heels, to thirty-one, Pioneers.

The next three innings added to the score for the Pioneers, the Tar Heels making only one run each inning, and the Pioneers making six, the seventh inning.

The ninth innings afforded the last opportunity for the Tar Heels to retrieve their fortunes, and they played courageously and well, and made thirty-nine runs, and the Pioneers had an innings yet to play. But they were unlucky in batting, and the Tar Heels very vigilant, so that not a run was made, and the game stood at thirty-nine for Pioneers, to thirty-three for Tar Heels.

Conover, it will be recalled, gave secret testimony before the Military Commission on the trial of the assassination conspirators.
