OUR RAILROADS.

MESSRS EDITORS.—In the present struggle for existence of our people and our industries, the railroads of the country must necessarily play an important role. The revival of the material prosperity of North Carolina and the recuperation of her business depend mainly upon her great lines of transportation. Such public works in every county and section furnish an equal and telltale index of the prosperity of its population. But this is not all, nor half. They are, moreover, the foundation and support of that prosperity. They should create the business of a country by developing its resources. A railroad which does not do this must be set down as essentially a failure. To be successful, it must be managed so as to evoke the energies of the people and all the capabilities of the soil and climate. It must build up its own business, which it can only do by building up at the same time that of the country. Any one who is familiar with the history of some of the great works of internal improvement of our day and country will readily recall illustrations of this statement. Consider for example the influence of the Erie Canal on the condition of New York, or the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad on the country through which it passes.
