Telegrams received during the day, on yesterday, informed our people that large delegations from glorious old New Hanover, and the counties on the line of the various Railroads, were en route for Raleigh, via Weldon and the Raleigh and Gaston Railroad.

About 7 o'clock, P. M., the city Young Men's Seymour and Blair Club turned in front of the Court House, and a cavalcade of thirty-seven mounted men wheeled into the same place. This organization was gotten up under the immediate auspices of our public-spirited young townsman, Thos G. Jenkins, Esq. Each horseman wore an appropriate scarlet of red, white and blue, and each horse's head was decorated with a flag bearing the inscription of the United States. At the head of the cavalcade the United States flag was carried by W. C. Parker, former color bearer of the 14th, N. C. Troops. The whole presented a highly imposing appearance.

The cortège moved to the Depot, accompanied by torch-bearers and a large concourse of citizens. About 9 o'clock, the whistle of the approaching engine set the crowd all abuzz with enthusiasm.—

On the cannon from a flat-car on the near-by track thundered forth, music abounding with thrilling strains, and cheer

cheer from hundreds of throats sent the air.

The various delegates were welcomed, in a stirring and appropriate address, by C. M. Bush, Esq., President of our Young Men's Club, which was most handsomely and eloquently replied to by Col. A. M. Wadsworth, of the New Hanover Delegation.

A procession was then formed, which marched through several of the streets to the Club room prepared for the New Hanover delegation. At every stage of its progress, loud and enthusiastic were the shouts and buzzes.

The New Hanover delegation was accompanied by a detachment of the colored Club of Wilmington, two bands of music, martial and instrumental, several minor transparencies, and one grand pyramid-shaped transpareny, carried on a wagon, exhibiting size-like scenes of Seymour and Blair and their full and patriotic mottoes.

A difficulty having occurred between a white man and a negro, it was made the pretext for a turbulent and riotous demonstration on the part of certain negroes—

Stone were thrown by them—one of which struck a young gentleman of the city, slightly, though slightly, wounding him.—The number of white men present was sufficient, had a collision taken place, to have annihilated the disturbers of the peace, which makes their prudence and forbearance the more commendable and remarkable. A. H. Galloway, of New Hanover, deserves great credit for his prompt return to the disorders met of his color, and his efforts to restrain their violent and insulting exhibitions.
