Present to appointment a party of the Seymour and Blair Club of this District met at Bookstown, on Saturday, the 26th September, for the purpose of permanently organizing the association.

The meeting was called to order by appointing Capt. Jas. S. Plafgar, President pro tem.

Whereupon, the following gentlemen were appointed a Committee to draft a Constitution, viz: R. Y. Kirkman, B. Y. Rayle and J. W. Goslin; which committee reported the following:

CONSTITUTION

Art. I. This association shall be styled the Brookston, Forsyth Co., Seymour and Blair Club.

Art. II. The objects of this association are as follows: To unite in close compact every patriotic citizen, by whatever name known in North Carolina, in the support and defence of the Constitution of the United States, the principles of the peace and good will of the people and the harmony of the Union; the proper enforcement of law and order by legitimate means...

Art. III. The officers of this Club shall consist of a President, Vice Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary and a Treasurer, who shall perform the duties of their respective offices.

Art. IV. This Constitution, and such By-Laws as may be adopted, may be changed at any public meeting by a two-thirds vote of the Club.

In accordance with the provisions of this Constitution, the following gentlemen were appointed a Committee to nominate permanent officers, viz: R. Y. Kirkman, W. H. Goslin and J. W. Goslin.

This Committee reported the following gentlemen, who were unanimously elected, viz: R. Y. Kirkman, President; J. W. Goslin, Vice President; R. Y. Rayle, Recording Secretary; J. W. Goslin, Corresponding Secretary; and Thos. A. ... Treasurer.
