Legislature of North Carolina.

Senate.

SATURDAY Dec. 12, 1868.

The Senate was called to order at 11 o'clock.

MEM. READ.

Mr. Lassiter presented a memorial signed by Messrs. Pearce and West, calling their attention to prepare a new map of the State, and giving the General Assembly to give them authority to execute the official documents of the State, with a resolution favorable to the memorialists, which was adopted.

REP. RT. OF COMMITTEE.

Mr. Rich, from the Committee on Internal Improvements, to whom was referred a bill to amend the charter of the Chatham and Guilford Railroad Company, reported favorably.

Mr. Bowman moved that the rule be suspended, and that Mr. Malone's resolution in regard to calling a Committee of Conference to confer with the Tennessee Legislature in regard to Railroad enterprises, be taken from the Calendar. Carried.

The resolution (published before) was read twice.

Mr. Malone took the floor in explanation of the resolution, and said that the object of this resolution is to enable this body to have an accurate view of the various projects of Railroads being manufactured by the State of Tennessee in the direction of Western North Carolina.

This object is to facilitate the building of this great system of Railroads, by which the traffic from the great States of Ohio, Kentucky, West Virginia, and East Tennessee, will pass through the State of North Carolina to the navigable point on the Seaboard. We wish to see progress in our sister State, and to avail ourselves of the opportunity to compare views. We simply propose to meet them in the city of Raleigh, therefore no expense will incur to the State of North Carolina. Our great section of Western North Carolina merits the attention of this body in order to develop our great resources, and then retire our surplus produce, and asking for it, *ad modum.*

Mr. Bowditch gave the Senator's fears were groundless, so far as that bill concerned. He felt as interested in this bill as did the Senator, if any appropriation was asked for, he should feel compelled to vote against it, as he would vote against any measure calculated to increase the already enormous debt of the State. He hoped that, before this bill was voted upon, anything it contained might be deleted. He was aware that it was rather *un-judicatus* to present a bill which asked for nothing.

Mr. Bowditch's motion was adopted, and the bill passed its final reading, unanimous.
