

STAY-LAW

WHEREAS the following from the Standard... As containing important matters to be remembered by the people...

On the 11th of May, 1861, the legislature passed an act, commonly known as the Stay Law; at the term of the supreme court held in June following...

For two reasons then, no suit for debt can now be brought in North Carolina, one reason is, this law expressly prohibits it...

There are other provisions of this law worthy of notice, to the effect that no man can now convey his property by deed of trust...

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of North Carolina, that it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same...

Sec. 2. Where such executions have issued and are now in the hands of officers, whether levied or not, the officer having such executions shall return the same to the magistrate...

Sec. 3. There shall be no trials of any cases requiring the intervention of a jury, nor upon warrants before a justice of the peace...

Sec. 4. This act shall not apply to liabilities upon the part of public officers, either to the State, counties, corporations or individuals...

THE STAMP ACT.

SEC. 7. That all mortgages and deeds in trust, for the benefit of creditors, heretofore executed, whether registered or not...
