WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—It appears that an erroneous statement in circulation in reference to the return of the Mexican Minister, on the occasion of his New Year's visit to the executive mansion, so far from the diplomatic corps having ignored him, as was currently reported, it is now known that he not only agreeably conversed with the Ministers whose governments have not, but also with several of those whose governments have recognized Maximilian's government. The Spanish Republics, as is believed, and also Prussia, are included in the former class.
