WASHINGTON, Jan. 14, 1866. ANOTHER OUTRAGE UPON SUMNER IN THE SENATE.

It was my happiness to be in the Senate this morning long enough to see Senator Sumner completely floored. He rose to rebuke Secretary McCullough, (who, by the by, was present), for daring to appoint assessors and collectors of the revenue in the South, who had not taken, and could not take the test oath, thus setting aside a law of Congress, or "dispensing" with it as Sumner phrased it.

And thereafter, Senator Davis stood up and stated his entire satisfaction that the Senator from Massachusetts should declare that the officers of the Government should obey the laws; but he wanted to know how many times Sumner had declared in the Senate that he never would obey the Fugitive Slave Act; how many times public officers in Massachusetts had set aside that law; and how often, under the plea of military necessity, during the last four years, the laws of the land had been frequently dispensed with.

Among the mustered out was "Brevet Brigadier" Detective L. C. Baker. It is known that his discharge was ordered by the President, who, not many months ago, ordered this same Baker out of the White House, and told him not to show face or foot on those premises again.

It is positively stated that Baker's discharge was not due to a willingness on the part of Stanton to dispense with the services of his "zealous and skillful instrument," but was in obedience to the "express command of the President;" and no stronger proof of the correctness of this statement is necessary than that Forney's Chronicle editorially denies it.

Baker goes into retirement a "Brevet Brigadier," but not a beggar. If he takes his chains and hand-cuffs with him he is rich—in old iron, anyhow. He carries, too, the undying friendship of Stanton and the whole school of free-speech suppressing, public-press squelching, and telegraph-tapping tyrants of the Radical party.

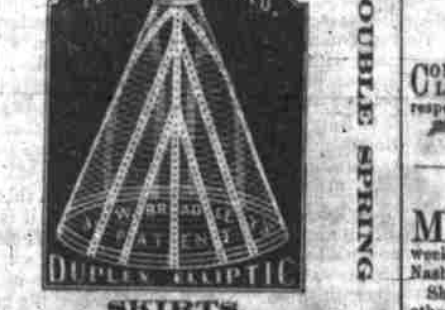
