Debate in Congress on the Freedmen's Bureau and Negro Suffrage.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 23.

SENATE.—The bill to enlarge the powers of the Freedmen's Bureau was called up. Mr. S. Salisbury said—The bill under consideration proposes to enlarge the powers of the Freedmen's Bureau. It does enlarge them wonderfully. I think I can demonstrate mathematically that this bill gives to the President of the United States, and to those entrusted with the discharge of these duties, the power of spending at least two hundred and fifty millions of dollars.

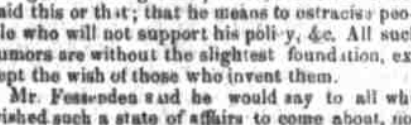
