LETTER OF GOV. COX OF OHIO.

President Johnson's Views in Detail. Washington, Monday, Feb. 20, 1865. General George B. Wright, Chairman Republican Central Committee, Columbus, O.

My DEAR SIR: On Saturday last I had the honor of an interview with the President, which I regarded as of sufficient interest and importance to make it proper that I should reduce to writing my recollections of his statements...

The President said he had no thoughts which he was not willing to avow—that his policy had simply aimed at the earliest possible restoration of peace, on the basis of loyalty.

Thus, in the case of the Freedmen's Bureau, he was not against the idea of the Bureau in toto; for he had used it, and was still using it. It might continue for more than a year yet.

Now but one thing remained in which those States did not exercise the full rights of States, and that was representation in Congress.

Such was his plan. He did not ask to be the judge of the election and qualifications of members of Congress or of their loyalty.
