FROM WASHINGTON.

Trial of Mr. Davis—Merchants' National Bank Failure, Etc.

WASHINGTON, May 10. It is stated on reliable authority that the Government has concluded to try Jeff. Davis in a civil court in the State of Virginia, and that it is not unlikely that Chief Justice Chase will preside, and Attorney General Speed conduct the prosecution.

The Merchants' National Bank is still opened daily, and the officers who remain at their posts continue to give comforting assurances to private depositors and others. It is now ascertained that the bank had no deposit of government funds from the Interior Department, on account of Indian funds, \$32,727; Post-office Department, dead letter fund, paper fund, and disbursing clerk, \$9,000; Treasury Department, \$5,000, and paymaster's and quartermaster's, \$640,163, total \$685,933.
