THE WAY THE MONEY GOES.

How goes the money? Well, I'm sure it isn't hard to tell; it goes for rents and water rates, for fuel and victual, coal and grain, for hats, caps and carriages, boots and shoes, and that's the way the money goes.

THE PHILOSOPHY OF RAIN. - To understand the philosophy of this beautiful and often sublime phenomenon, so often witnessed since the creation of the world, and so essential to the very existence of plants and animals, a few facts derived from observation and a long train of experiments must be remembered:

1. Were the atmosphere everywhere, at all times, of a uniform temperature, it should never rain or hail, or snow. The water absorbed by it in evaporation from the sea and the earth's surface would descend in an imperceptible vapor, or cease to be absorbed by the air when it was once fully saturated.

2. The absorbing power of the atmosphere, and consequently its capacity to retain humidity, is proportionately greater in warm than in cold air.

3. The air near the surface of the earth is warmer than the air in the regions of the clouds. The higher we ascend from the earth the colder we find the atmosphere. Hence the perpetual snow on very high mountains in the hottest climate.

4. Now, when from continued evaporation the air is highly saturated with vapor, though it is invisible and the sky cloudless, if its temperature is suddenly reduced by cold currents descending from above, or rushing from a higher to a lower latitude, or by the motion of saturated air to a colder latitude, its capacity to retain moisture is diminished, clouds are formed, and the result is rain.

5. The air near the surface of the earth is warmer than the air in the regions of the clouds. The higher we ascend from the earth the colder we find the atmosphere. Hence the perpetual snow on very high mountains in the hottest climate.
