THE BANKRUPT LAW. The Act to Establish a Uniform System of Bankruptcy Throughout the United States—What the Bill is—What it Provides.

The substance of the most important bill just passed by the Senate and House, and approved by the President, will be found as follows in the summary that we give:

Section 1. The several District Courts of the United States, and the several Circuit Courts of Appeals, in addition to the other jurisdiction they now have...
