that he was confined for five months in a jail. In 1780, Davis was placed at the head of a legionary corps, with the commission of Major from the Governor of North Carolina. He spent the last of his life in a quiet and unobtrusive manner, and he was buried in the city of Raleigh, N. C., on the 22d of August, 1837.

When Greene, the noble Masonic associate of Washington, took command of the Southern army, he appointed his brother, Col. Davis, his Commissary General. In all the important operations which followed, Davis was exceedingly efficient; and at the trying hour at Ninety Six, in the summer of 1781, Greene sent Col. Davis to present the condition of his army to the Legislature of North Carolina. He performed the service well; and prospects of peace appearing in the autumn, he left the army, and married a daughter of General Allen Jones, in 1783.

He was elected Governor of the State of North Carolina, and was soon afterwards appointed by President Adams as an associate envoy extraordinary to France, with Ellsworth and Murray. After his return he went to reside at Tivoli, a beautiful estate on the Catawba river, in South Carolina. He died in 1803, and he remained in retirement until his own death, which occurred at Tivoli, in December, 1830, when he was in the sixty-fourth year of his age.

Governor Davis is believed to have been made a Mason in the "Royal White Hart" Lodge at Halifax, which had existed in Halifax from the year 1763, but whose members were suspended during the war. In 1787, upon the return of peace, the old Lodge resumed work, and formed a Grand Lodge for North Carolina, of which Governor Davis became the first Grand Master, and in which office he continued until he became the French Ambassador, in 1799.

The Masonic "North Carolina University," at Chapel Hill, which has cost forth so many distinguished men and means into all the departments of life, is indebted to Bro. Davis as a founder and friend. As Grand Master, he laid the corner-stone on the 14th of April, 1798.
