HEADQUARTERS SECOND MILITARY DISTRICT.

By the terms of the Act of Congress entitled "An Act to provide for the more efficient government of the military districts," passed March 2, 1907, and of the Act of March 2, 1907, supplementary thereto, it is made the duty of the commanding general of this Military District to cause to be held in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, a general election to be held at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.

First. That an election be held in the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.

Second. That the duty of the Board of Registrars of each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, shall be to cause to be held in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, a general election to be held at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.

Third. In holding any election to be held in any County in any District, the Board of Registrars shall be guided by the law of March 2, 1907, and the laws supplementary thereto, and their attention is called to the fact that the Board of Registrars of each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, shall be to cause to be held in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, a general election to be held at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.

Fourth. That the election to be held in each County in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, shall be held at the same time and place as the election to be held in the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, and the laws supplementary thereto, and their attention is called to the fact that the Board of Registrars of each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, shall be to cause to be held in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, a general election to be held at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.

Fifth. That the Board of Registrars of each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, shall be to cause to be held in each of the military districts of the State of North Carolina, on the 20th day of November, 1907, a general election to be held at which the registered voters of said State shall vote for or against a Convention, for the purpose of submitting to the people of the State a proposition to amend the Constitution and the State Constitution, and to elect delegates to said Convention.
