## The Bankruptcy Act.

We have been requested to publish the Bankruptcy Law. This is impossible, it is a voluminous and complicated volume. In order, however, that our readers may understand it, and may therefore be able to be helped upon its provisions, we have prepared a summary of its provisions, which we will publish in our next issue.

The following is a summary of the provisions of the Bankruptcy Act, as amended by the Act of February 22, 1868.

1. The manifest design of the Bankruptcy Law is to benefit the debtor, but not to injure the creditor.

2. To become a voluntary bankrupt under this Act, the debtor must own at least one estate, which is not in a state of insolvency.

3. Petitioners under the Bankruptcy Act are required to render a schedule of all their debts and liabilities, of every kind and description, and also an inventory of all their estate, both real and personal, including all property and effects of which they are possessed, or in which they may have an interest, though not in possession, in conformity with certain forms prescribed in the Act.

4. When the petition is filed, the case is immediately referred to a Register, who examines the petition and schedule annexed thereto, and if they are correct in form, makes a certificate to that effect, to be filed with the Clerk, who then issues a writ of sequestration against the debtor's estate, and appoints an Assignee to take charge of the Bankrupt's estate.

5. A creditor can, however, prove his claim at any time previous to the last dividend, which will generally be six months subsequent to the date of the filing of the petition.

6. The Assignee has no right to compel the Bankrupt to answer any question concerning the property or property of his estate, or to file a petition in Bankruptcy, or to do any other act, until the date of the filing of the petition by or against a debtor, at which date, if adjudication of bankruptcy follows, the old order of things ceases to exist, and a new law is introduced.
