Accounts which I have recently seen from the South represent the radical organization there as terribly demoralized. Except in Louisiana, it is now thought doubtful whether the Legislature of the seven reconstructed States will assume the power of appointing electoral votes. Virginia, Mississippi and Texas will, in some way, not prevented by the force of the United States under the orders of the bogus State authorities, select electors and their votes for Congress. It is understood that the President had long advised this course. In respect to the political sentiments of the Cabinet, I learn that Messrs. Browning and Wells may be relied on as sincere friends of the Democratic ticket. Accounts are contrary as to the other members. Randall is disgusted, it is said, with politics and has declared his position to be that of neutral neutrality. Schofield will of course adhere to the Republican candidate. McCulloch is reticent, and whatever may be said to the contrary, Seward and Evarts occupy doubtful attitudes. In truth, none of these men have a political future. If the Democrats succeed in November, a clean sweep will be made from the White House to the other end (contrary to all signs). The Radicals shall triumph, the whole of the present Cabinet, together with Fessenden, Trumbull, Henderson, Rose, Van Winkle and Fowler, will be unceremoniously thrown overboard. The Radicals, however, will be without other patronage, as the prospective and unconstitutional action of Congress has left scarcely a single Democrat or real Conservative in office.

RECONSTRUCTION TROUBLES AT THE SOUTH.

LOUISIANA—A NEGRO DEMOCRAT NERDED.

NEW ORLEANS, August 2.
A negro named Willis Rollins, has been making Democratic speeches in the city for the last week, and around the camp of the Radicals, both white and black. Several attempts have been made on his life. On Saturday night a crowd followed him several squares trying to drag him from a street car. In making his escape he was arrested on a charge of sedition. He was released on bail. On yesterday another attack with a stinging mob was made on him.

This morning on appearing before the Recorder, it was found that the original charge of inciting to riot was dropped, and the charge of carrying concealed weapons substituted. He was discharged, and his release his life was again threatened by the excited negroes, but he was escorted in safety by his friends to the room of the Constitution Club, on Canal street, as the neighborhood of which the excited crowd gathered.

Gov. Warmoth appeared and made a short and effective speech, telling the negroes that they should rather protect Rollins in the public expression of his opinion, than seek to deprive him of that right. He advised the crowd to disperse and go home, which they did. Gov. Warmoth's speech is highly spoken of.
