IN RELATION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF CLERKS OF SUPERIOR COURTS.

SECTION 1. That as this act will be incorporated in the general act respecting the practice and procedure of the courts, required to be reported to the General Assembly at its present session, by the committee appointed for that purpose, it will be printed in the general act, and not elsewhere among the acts of this General Assembly, unless otherwise hereinafter directed.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of State is required to have the third section of this act, and that portion relating to the Superior Court Clerks, printed in this State weekly in four pages published in this State, and the sum necessary for this purpose is hereby appropriated from any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 3. The terms of the several Superior Courts of this State shall begin in each year at the times hereinafter stated, and shall continue to be held for two weeks (Sundays and legal holidays excepted) unless the business shall be sooner disposed of.

OF THE QUALIFICATIONS AND GENERAL DUTIES OF CLERKS OF THE SUPERIOR COURTS.

SEC. 1. At the first meeting of the County Commissioners of each county after the election or appointment of any Clerk of a Superior Court, it shall be the duty of the Clerk to deliver to the Commissioners a complete and faithful record of all his official acts, and give copies thereof to all persons desiring them, on payment of the legal fees.

EXECUTION DOKERS.

SEC. 4. A docket of all writs of summons or other original process issued by him or returned to his office, before a jury, and of all other matters, before the judge, at a regular term of the Court, a copy of which shall be furnished to the Judge at the commencement of each term.

SEC. 5. An alphabetical index, according to the names of the plaintiffs, of all final judgments in civil action, rendered in the Court, with the dates and numbers thereof.

SEC. 6. A docket of all criminal actions, containing a note of every proceeding in each, by whom the books are to be furnished.

SEC. 7. The books specified in the above section shall be supplied to the clerk of the several counties by the Secretary of State, at the expense of the State, and the Secretary shall, as soon as possible, transmit a copy thereof to the Chairman of the County Commissioners, in order that the price may be levied in the county taxes, and also the Auditor of public accounts, who shall add the same to the taxes of the respective counties, and receive and account for it as for other taxes. The Commissioners of each county failing to cause such sum to be levied with the other county taxes, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SEPARATE.

SEC. 10. The clerk shall keep the papers in each action in a separate roll or bundle, and at its termination attach together, properly labeled, and file them in order of the date of the final judgment.

SOLICITORS TO EXAMINE RECORDS, &c.

SEC. 11. At every regular term of the Superior Court, the Solicitor for the Judicial District shall inspect the office of the Clerk and report to the Court in writing, if any Clerk, after being furnished with the necessary books shall fail to keep them up as required by law, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and the Solicitor shall cause him to be prosecuted for the same. If the Solicitor shall fail or neglect to perform the duty hereby imposed on him, he shall be liable to a penalty of five hundred dollars to any person who shall sue for the same.

EXISTING SUITS.

SEC. 12. Nothing in this act contained shall affect or impair any right given by an ordinance of the Convention of this State, entitled "an Ordinance respecting the jurisdiction of the Courts of this State," ratified the 14th day of March 1868, in so far as to which it is applicable.
