SHILOH AND BEAUMONTE CONVENTION
AT ASHEVILLE.

A meeting of delegates from the several Counties composing the Seventh Congressional District, held in Asheville on the 27th instant, Mr. J. K. Kenner, of Jackson, was chosen Chairman, and D. H. Graves, of Henderson, requested to act as Secretary.

The object of the Convention was briefly explained by the President, when called to the Chair, as follows: "The nomination of a Conservative Democratic candidate for Congress in this District, and a District Elector for President, on the Seymour and Blair ticket."

The Convention being now organized, a motion was made by Mr. J. J. Osborne, of Henderson, for the Chair to appoint a Committee of five to devise a plan by which each County should be entitled to vote, and to decide upon the eligibility of delegates from the different Counties. The motion having been carried, the following Committee was appointed, viz.: Messrs. J. D. Osborne, G. W. Whitehead, R. M. Dickson, Capt. N. Kohler and Col. Neatby.

A motion was made and carried, to the effect that a Committee be appointed, whose duty it should be to designate business for the consideration of the Convention, which Committee consisted of Col. J. D. Hyman, Capt. W. M. Cocke, Capt. C. M. McLeod, Capt. C. Hardy and Mr. E. M. Peeler.

During the absence of said Committee, Capt. H. D. Vining was called for and addressed the meeting. The General showed clearly the baselessness of the Radical party, and the means they had devised to engulf the country in纷乱 trouble, perhaps awaking us from the quiet walks and peaceful dreams of an idle life to the deadly shock of arms!

Mr. James H. Morrison being called upon, eloquently responded, demonstrating the oppressive designs of the party in power, urging the people to seize their duty in the coming election.

The Committee charged with the preparation of business for the Convention, having returned, made the following report,

namely, that a Committee be appointed

to consider the nomination of a candidate for Elector and Assistant Elector,

and that the Seymour and Blair Clubs of the several counties comprising the District be requested to appoint Assistant Electors in their respective counties.

Resolved, That this Convention pledge themselves to each other and the country to use all fair and honorable means to redress the State from Radical rule, and restore the country to its purity, as it existed in the days of Washington and the fathers of the country.

The above resolutions were unanimously adopted by the Convention.

Capt. Cook was now called for, and addressed the meeting at length, in his usual clear, logical, impressive manner, proving that the success of the Radical party in the coming election would be the death knell of American liberty, substantiating his position by figures and facts.

The Committee that had been appointed to determine a plan by which each County should vote, and to decide upon the eligibility of delegates, reported their decision that every county should be entitled to one vote, and every 500 over one entitled to one, the calculation being made from the registered vote; and that all who were nominated by a gentleman from the Convention, were considered as delegates.

A motion was made and carried to appoint a committee on nominations, consisting of Messrs. T. C. Westall, Capt. C. Hardy, Col. Cocke, Capt. A. E. Posey, Captain Nat. Wilson, Capt. W. M. Rice, Mr. E. M. Peeler, Captain C. M. McLeod, Capt. C. Hardy, Capt. G. W. Whitehead, and G. M. Whiteday.

A recess of an hour having been taken, the Convention reassembled, when Col. McLeod, being called on, addressed the meeting on the status of the day, and like those who preceded him in the morning's meeting, demonstrated the amiable motives of the party in power.

The Committee on nominations made and submitted the following report, which was endorsed unanimously by the Convention:
