NOMINATING CONVENTION OF FIFTH DISTRICT.
GREENSBORO, N. C., SEPT. 8, 1868.

The Delegates appointed by the different counties of the Fifth Congressional District met in the Odd Fellows Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Gen. A. M. Scales, who after a few remarks moved that Ralph Ogilvie, Esq., be called to the Chair.

On motion of S. P. Hill, Esq., G. M. Mathews, of Forsythe, and Jas. W. A. Wright, of Guilford, were appointed Secretaries.

Upon a call by counties, delegates were ascertained to be present from all the counties except Surry and Stanley.

On motion of S. P. Hill, a Committee of one from each county was appointed, to suggest suitable names for Elector on the Presidential Ticket.

The nominations were unanimously concurred in by the Convention.

On motion, five additional sub-electors were appointed for each County, to wit: W. C. Graham, Dr. J. A. Moore, Jas. E. Boyd, David W. Kerr.

The following resolution, offered by Hon. John Kerr, was unanimously adopted:

Resolved, That this Convention, representing the feelings and wishes of the people of this Congressional District, are truly sensible of their obligations of gratitude to David P. Caldwell, Esq., for his earnest devotion to the interests of our country, and especially for the ability displayed by him in defence of the principles of the Democratic Conservative party in the late canvass for Congress in this District.

In response to this resolution, Mr. Caldwell, in a most forcible and patriotic speech, gave a full and complete account of his services in the late canvass.

The Court House being declared vacant, the chair announced that the further proceedings would be conducted from that place.

Resolved, That while we deprecate any and all violence and carnage, we nevertheless maintain our just rights and the rights of all who are associated with us in our struggle for the restoration of civil liberty; and, especially, we will support and defend the generous, brave and gallant colored people who have united with the Democratic party, and who stand exposed to the insults and injuries of Radicals, and who, without aid, will be subjected to such coercion as will deprive them of the right of voting as they please.
