MASS MEETING IN LEXINGTON.
A large meeting of the citizens of Davidson County, was held in the Court House, in Lexington, on the 6th day of February.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTIONS were then introduced and unanimously adopted.
WHEREAS, before the late war, a custom prevailed in this State, among the people, by which business and trade was chiefly carried on, commonly known as the credit system, and by means of which the people became largely involved in debt;

WHEREAS, the basis upon which this credit system prevailed, or the property which stood as a basis and pledge, or security, for the extension of this system, have been swept away by the ravages of civil war, whereby the people, almost in every case, are unable to pay the full amount of the debts thus contracted; and

WHEREAS, it is absolutely essential that these old debts, which are now paralyzing the energies of the people, should be speedily settled, in order that the people might turn their attention to industrial and economic pursuits, and thereby become able to pay taxes to the government, to contribute to the support of the State, and to insure a prosperous future for the whole land; therefore

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be transmitted by the Secretary to the President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives of North Carolina, with a request that they have their respective copies furnished the Raleigh Standard and Sentinel for publication; and that all the papers in the State be requested to copy them.

On motion, the meeting was adjourned.
