CITY OF RALEIGH, March 6, 1869.
An ordinance of the Legislature, adopted by the
Board of Commissioners, calling in their opinion,
that an election will be held on the 8th day of
April, 1869, at the Court House, in this City,
whether the question of the approval or disapproval
of the proposed amendment to the Constitution
of the United States, shall be submitted to the
voters of the City of Raleigh in the manner, and
for the purposes mentioned in the following
resolution of the General Assembly of North Carolina.

AN ACT TO NAME THE CITY OF RALEIGH TO BOSTON.

NEW MONEY FOR CANAL PECULIAR.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do order: RESOLVED, That for the purposes of paying the indebtedness of the City of Raleigh, and for meeting the expenses of improvements to be made for the same, the City is hereby author- ized and empowered to issue bonds payable at such sums respectively, bearing interest at such rate, not exceeding eight per cent, per annum, and half yearly, of said sum and interest thereon, to be paid semi-annually, on the 1st day of January and July, in each year, in the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS in the manner, and for the purposes mentioned in the following resolution of the General Assembly of North Carolina.
