TURNER'S MASSACHUSETTS IN THE OLDEN TIME.

One of the most accomplished historical authors in the country, Mr. J. W. Turner, of Boston, has recently discovered the form of paper marriage prepared and used by the Rev. Mr. Turner, of the Massachusetts, whose ministry was begun in 1730, and ending with his death in 1771, was a prolonged and a deeply distinguished service of more than half a century. His immediate ancestor was the Reverend Joseph Turner, 1709, in the family of which Mr. Turner found the document at Northampton, N. H., on the thirty-first of December, 1868. I am indebted to his liberal courtesy for the opportunity to make use of it at the present time.

It is copied exactly from the original now before me, and the initials are marked by the author himself, whose words could hardly have been more than the most approved and orthodox pattern.

A FORM FOR A NEGRO-MARRIAGE.

You: I do now, in the Presence of God, and these Witnesses, Take R. to be your Wife.
