It is especially noteworthy that most of the collections are made in small sums, varying from one dollar to ten dollars, thus showing the sympathy with the sufferers is very widespread, touching all classes, and calling for the widow's mite as well as the corporation's purse. It is now rarely made a proper use of this great charity, dispensing it with impartiality, promptly and prudently. That so many of the contributions are from those who could ill spare them makes the obligation of a wise use of the fund the more imperative."
