PROCEEDINGS OF SYNOD

Wilmington, Oct. 12, 1870. Synod met in the Presbyterian Church at 9 o'clock, A. M. Rev. A. S. Smith, Moderator in the Chair.

Sessions was opened by religious services by the Moderator.

There being called, there was a considerable number of members, both ministers and ruling elders, to those present at the opening last evening.

The Synod embraces the Presbyteries of Orange, Concord, Fayetteville, Wilmington and Minkleyburg.

Roll of orders, and names of members, were read, showing an encouraging state of things among the Churches.

Ordered, that the subject of Sentimental or Domestic Missions, be the first order of business for Oct. 13, A. M., to-morrow.

The subject of Sentimental Missions was made the order for Oct. 13, P. M., to-morrow.

The subject of Publication was made the order for Saturday at 10 o'clock, A. M.

During the session quite a discussion sprung up on the subject of a presbyterial order.

Synod fixed the meeting of its next session at Fayetteville.

It was announced that Rev. Mr. Harding would preach to-morrow (Friday) night.

Synod then took recess at 10 o'clock, to meet again at 7 o'clock P. M.

Afternoon Session. The Synod resumed its sitting at 4 o'clock, P. M.

Moderator presiding, the discussion upon the subject of the records of the Wilmington Presbytery was continued.

On motion the matter was temporarily postponed.

Rev. Mr. Curtis submitted a report from the Committee on the Minutes of the death of the Rev. J. J. Lynch. The report was accepted and adopted.

On motion the report on the records of the Wilmington Presbytery was taken up, and after some little debate, was adopted.

Rev. Mr. Isler offered an ordinance from the Wilmington Presbytery to settle the boundary line between the Orange and Wilmington Presbyteries.

Rev. Mr. Monroe offered a resolution to change the boundaries between the Wilmington and Orange Presbyteries.
